SPARKLING

ITGIS001 Giribaldi DOCG Moscato d'Asti 2008

Straw yellow character, and full of white evanescent froth. Intensed floral aroma, fruity with notes of sage and citrus with hints of melon and pineapple. Sweet with a good balance in the mouth between acid and sugar. Hints of golden apple and an intense aromatic aftertaste.

WHITE

ITGIW001 Giribaldi Gavi di Gavi DOCG 2005

Wonderfully soft and light, the Cortese grape makes fresh and perfumed wines of distinction. The Giribaldi Gavi has a pale straw-yellow colour with a delicate floral bouquet The wine is dry and well structured with a fresh and light fruity flavour and a soft aftertaste of grapes and lemons.

RED

ITGIR001 Giribaldi DOC Barbera d'Alba 2006

Intensed ruby red and vinuous to the nose with notes of vanilla and liquorice sensations. Dry warm with spicy notes, tobacco, vanilla and red fruit marmalade.

ITGIR002 Giribaldi DOCG Barolo 2004

A ruby red colour with amaranth reflexes, an evident perception of good fruit appeals to the nose, floral with hints of roses and cherries, dry and austere in the mouth, optimal ribbing with sweet tannins and sensations of tobacco.

ITGIR002 Giribaldi DOCG Barbaresco 2001

Ruby red, turning garnet red with age. A floral perfume with particular notes of wild roses, raspberries and cinnamon. Dry balanced taste with scents of Vanilla, leather and tobacco.

AUSTRIA

Weingut Wieninger has, over the years claim its place as one of the more accomplished winemaker in Austria. Noted in the Parkers Wine Guide, 6th Edition as one of the best in the country, 'Mister Chardonnay' has emerged indisputably the number one producer in the capital and appreciated far beyond the borders of Austria.

After expanding the vine reign to the other side of the Danube River, to source even better grapes from the famous Nussberg, Vienna's best vineyard site. Wieninger certainly knows how to get the best out of it and has gained an impressive reputation for his barrel-fermented Chardonnay and barrel-aged Pinot Noir from the Premium range "Grand Select". In addition to this the mineraly Grüner Veltliner from Nussberg and the spicy case-scented Cabernet Merlot blend are all worthy of attention.

AUWWR001 Wieninger Wiener Trilogie 2002

(70% Zweigelt, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot)

Ruby color. Intense aromas of red berries and consommée, a lot of substance. Rich berries on the palate, well balanced tannins, quite some acidity, to mature

AUWWR002 Wieninger Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot 2000

Garnet red. Blackcurrants and vistula, Complexly textured, good tannins, aftertaste like red berries. Capable of long-term maturation.

AUWWR004 Wieninger Blauburgunder Grand Select 2000

Ruby Color. Crimson, multilayered and complex, red berries and coconut flavours on the nose. Sweet and juicy with slight coconut aromas on the palate, classical pinot noir.

Weingut Malat

A significant part of Austrian wine history is connected to the Malat name. Gerald Malat's pioneer spirit contributed to the cabernet sauvignon grapes being planted in Austria for the first time ... in a classic wine region.

When he took over the winery in 1976, the area covered just ten hectares. Over time, the flagship enterprise was expanded to 40 hectares. Today, the Malat Estate is amongst the top Austrian wineries. It is hardly surprising that Malat wines are served at Austrian state banquets.

The Malat family does not follow every wine fashion because it sets trends rather than following the spirit of the times. As such, here at the Malat Estate, we turn exquisite grape varieties into wine.

The palette ranges from the fragrant Muscat grape to the meditative grey burgundy, from the well-known St. Laurent to the cabernet sauvignon, which has been one of the most popular red wines of the house since its pioneering days. The major grape varieties of the area are, of course, the outstanding green Veltliner and Riesling, which are also produced as "the best of..." great reserves if the year allows.

The estate of MAX FERD. RICHTER has been in the ownership of the family for more than 300 years. Today this enterprise is one of the leading producers of top RIESLING Wines in the middle Mosel with total holdings of 40 acres and an annual production of about 11.500 cases.

MAX FERD. RICHTER not only produces fine RIESLING Wines which are well known throughout the world, such as "Graacher Himmelreich", "Wehlener Sonnenuhr" and "Brauneberger Juffer". But also two exclusive top quality wines: "Mülheimer Helenkloster" and "Veldenzer elisenberg". The terroir of their steep vineyard sites is generally fresh weathering grey slate with different compositions of ferruginous mineral quartz or clay parts; those that make the character flavour.

The EISWEINS from the Mülheimer Helenkloster vineyard are well known and are a specialty of the RICHTER estate. The estate are the only one in the Mosel to produce an EISWEIN in 1976. Since the family has always been aiming at Optimum quality, the estate of MAX FERD. RICHTER has obtained many of the highest awards in various national and international competitions. They are truly a representation of the cultural heritage of the unique Mosel landscape.

GEDDW019 2007 Mülheimer Sonnenlay Riesling, Qba, Zeppelin-Label

Straw-yellow in color. Fresh fruity with nice apple and lemon nose. On the palate, juicy and luscious on palate and finishes with spicy and long lasting harmonic built in fruit acid. The wine is thriven by rich slate minerality.

This single vineyard Riesling was successfully served on the flights of the "Graf Zeppelin" in the 1920s and 1930s. The growers of Mülheim on Mosel, being particularly proud of that privilege, have ask Hans Schlösser, a famous painter and member of the Weimar/Dessau Bauhaus group to design a label incorporating the Zeppelin.

GEDDW008 2003 Mulheimer Helenenkloster Riesling Eiswein Grapes Picked on 3rd January 2004 R.P: 91pts

Yellowish gold in color. Apples, litchees, apricots, rich concentrated grapy sweetness. On the mouthfill, luscious mineral flavour balanced by fine, lean tartaric acid

A dessert wine to match fruit dessert and cream cheese creations, but working as sorbet as well to reanimate all taste buds.

GEDDW020 2007 Richter Estate Riesling, Qba

Straw-yellow in color. Great peach and melon fruit in the nose. Some touchy sweetness that freshens your taste buds. The mineral texture carries the perfect balance of residual sugar and fruit acid and finishes with clean dry lingering structure. Very elegant and pleasant.

GEDDW011 1997 Brauneberger Juffer Riesling, Spätlese

Golden yellow in color. Intense aroma of white peaches. The taste is characterized by spicy and animating resident sweetness and refreshing harmonic fruit acid. Medium bodied Spätlese, noble, elegance and very delicate.

GEDDW012 2003 Graacher Dompropst Riesling, Spätlese

Pale yellow in color. Mineral richness and flavours of lime, peaches and slatestone. Shows full bodied rounded and spicy character. Exact revelation of the nose. Long lasting aftertaste and a clean dry lingering finish. Well balanced in pure fruit and acid.

GEDDW013 1998 Graacher Dompropst Riesling, Auslese

Golden yellow. Peaches, apples and quince aromas. Concentrated citrus and green fruits, backed by mineral flavours and long savoury fruit finish. Grand Cru vineyard of Germany! The wines from the Dompropst vineyard do need ageing- they are marathon runners!

GEDDW014 2003 Graacher Himmelreich Riesling, Auslese

Straw-yellow in color. Opulent, pungent rich wine with typical Mosel elegance and fragrance. Clean peach apple fruit structure backed by exotic fruit elements and good concentration. Mid bodied and long finish.

GEDDW015 2003 Mülheimer Helenkloster Riesling, Auslese

Straw-yellow in color. Spice with tropical fruits and minerals. Explosive entry with plenty of tropical fruits and elegant spice. Mid bodied with a lengthy finish.

GEDDW021 2007 Graacher Dompropst Riesling, Kabinett, Offdryish

Straw-yellow in color. Intensified ripe apples and lemon, with fine, bright and invigorating on the palate and manages that special 2007 character evincing substantial richness and sheer extract while being light to the touch and uplifting in the finish. There is admirable purity on display here along with elegance, spice and racy long lasting aftertaste.

GEDDW022 2007 Brauneberger Juffer Riesling, Kabinett

Dirk Richter's wines are made in wonderful deep cellars at Mülheim. This has the typical earthy/mineral character of Brauneberg wines together with tremendous richness of fruit and lovely acidity.. It has the live-wire structure of a Saar or Ruwer wine.

GEDDW023 2007 Riesling Classic, Qba

A drystyle Riesling from carefully handpicked grapes of 40 years old vines of the Max Ferd. Richter estate. Selected by Dr. Richter the flavour reveals delicate nose of peach and lime with animating character on palate with slatyness and minerality. Crisp and with firm body, it exhibits density and good weight. A vibrant, characteristic dry style Mosel Riesling.

Viña Valdivieso

Viña Valdivieso dates back to 1879 when Alberto Valdivieso founded Champagne Valdivieso, the first company in Chile and South America to make sparkling wine. More than a hundred years later in the late 1980s, the company expanded in a new direction when it began commercial production of still wines, as Viña Valdivieso, in our Curicó Valley winery in Lontué.

Valdivieso wines have since had a very successful career, triumphing in major world markets and achieving the highest honours in international competitions. These achievements are not an objective in themselves, but rather the result of the search for superior quality wines that are both distinctive and attractive.

Rochford Winery

Rochford Wines produce award winning cool climate wine from both their Macedon Ranges and Yarra Valley Vineyards. Winemaker, David Creed, who graduated top of his class at Roseworthy, has a simple approach "Produce the best fruit possible in the vineyard; handle the fruit gently to preserve fruit character; minimise extraction and allow the wines to express the individuality of the vineyard and each growing season".

Rochford consistently produces wines that express the unique conditions of their cool-climate vineyards and each individual vintage. The wines are characterised by concentrated, complex fruit underlined with firm structure to ensure longevity. David's expertise in wine making and cool climate wine production have earned him much kudos and many accolades along the way, the most notable at this point in time being the "Best Pinot Noir Trophy at the Royal Melbourne Wine Show 2002" for his Rochford Macedon Ranges Pinot Noir 2000 and "2006 Decanter World Wine Award Trophy for best Australian Pinot Noir" for the 2003 Macedon Ranges Pinot Noir.

ASRWR006 Rochford R Shiraz Reserve 2003

Deep plum red. Dark berry fruits and spice complexed with mocha and smoky notes. Rich with an excellent depth of flavor and overall balance. The finish is long with soft grape tannins and well-balanced acidity.

Linda Domus Wines

Linda Domas and her viticulturist Steve Brunato are an unusual pair who prefer the challenges of making wine in Bulgaria and Tunisia, North Africa to California and the South of France. Having returned to the relatively secure surrounds of their birthplace in McLaren Vale there had to be a challenge. They set about the idea of making beautifully citrus laden white wines from Southern Fleurieu, using Mount Compass as their fruit source which is significantly cooler than McLaren Vale or Flat.

WHITE**ASLDW002 2006 Saliency Sauvignon Blanc**

Pale lemon with green tinges. Lime juice and peardrop aromas prevail. The palate has strong minerality, lemon grass and passionfruit flavours.

RED**ASLDR001 2003 Shotbull Shiraz – Southern Fleurieu**

Intensed deep red. Displays rich and concentrated raspberry and redcurrant aromas over clove and white pepper with hints of chocolate from the new French Oak. The palate is opulent and controlled. Fine grain tannins coupled with fruit sweetness and a touch of warmth from alcohol deliver a complex and elegant wine.

ASLDR002 2005 Boycat Merlot – McLaren Vale

Deep Ruby Red. Displays rich plums with violet aromas over spice. Fruit dominant, the palate is supple than restrained. Oak is supportive rather than dominant. Hints of spice and warmth from alcohol give great length. Best with strong cheese or game.

ASLDR003 2003 Egidio Shiraz – McLaren Vale

Deep red with purple hues. Displays red berry fruit and raspberry aromas. Fruit dominant, the palate is full bodied yet restrained. Oak is supportive rather than dominant. Hints of spice and warmth from alcohol give great length.

Gallie Estate (Camelback)

Established in 1997 the original Galli Estate vineyard, occupies 100 acres at Rockbank in the renowned Sunbury winegrowing region of Victoria. Just 40 minutes northwest of Melbourne, the Rockbank vineyard is planted predominantly with Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon along with smaller blocks of Pinot Noir, Pinot Grigio, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon.

In 2001 Lorenzo and Pamela developed their 250 acre Camelback vineyard in the famous Central Victorian winegrowing region of Heathcote - a region now synonymous with outstanding Australian Shiraz. Camelback vineyard features mainly Shiraz with lesser plantings of two other "Rhone" varieties; Viognier and Grenache. The balance is planted to Cabernet Sauvignon and the Italian varieties Sangiovese, Nebbiolo and Tempranillo which, in keeping with Lorenzo's innovative nature are new to Australia but show exciting potential.

It is not by chance that both of these vineyards have soil profiles wonderfully suited to producing ultra premium fruit from low yielding vines. Affectionately known as "our two reds", the free draining, rich, red volcanic soils of Sunbury and the famous red Cambrian volcano/sedimentary soils of Heathcote were fundamental to Lorenzo's dream.

WHITE**ASGEW001 Camelback Chardonnay Semillon 2006**

This is a fresh vibrant wine bursting peach, lemon and tropical fruit flavour, while the finish fresh, crisp and clean. It is a wine that is best enjoyed while it retains its youthful freshness and is the perfect accompaniment to seafood and light white meat dishes

ASGEW002 Camelback Chardonnay 2007

This wine has a deep straw colour. Aromas of grapefruit and white peach with nutty oak lead to a fine intense and creamy palate with a long, lingering finish.

ASGEW003 Camelback Sauvignon Blanc 2008 – Latest Arrival

Pale straw in colour with a touch of green, this wine has lively lime and melon with a touch of fresh herbs on the nose. These characters follow through on the palate along with gooseberry and lemon. The palate is soft and persistent with a clean finish. While there are green herbal notes, this is not a New Zealand style herbaceous gooseberry Sauvignon Blanc. This wine is softer and juicier and more of a well balanced food wine. It is designed to drink young and fresh, but will cellar for 1-2 years, developing a more honeyed character.

ASGEW004 Camelback Pinot Grigio 2008 – Latest Arrival

Pale in colour, this wine exhibits aromas of lime blossom, grapefruit, and a touch of musk. The palate exhibits these flavours plus lime and lemon juice, cooking apples, and some floral notes. It finishes clean and fresh with a chalky, talc like astringency which makes it the perfect accompaniment to stronger flavoured fish, and other seafoods.

RED**ASGER001 Camelback Dry Red 2005 (Cabernet, Merlot and Shiraz)**

**ASGER002 Camelback Tempranillo, Grenache & Mourvedre 2006

The nose is redolent of forest berries, particularly raspberry and blueberry, dusted with warming spice. The palate is brimming with soft juicy blueberries, spice and lemon pip, with just a touch of gamey charcuterie. The finish is clean and satisfying, leaving you wanting more. SPMPR002 Mas Perinet Plus 2004, Priorat

Complex, elegant and very concentrated nose of ripe red fruits, layered with hints of minerals, spices and wood. It balanced fruits, earthy and woody tones. It is smooth, pleasant, silky and full-bodied in the mouth. It has sweet, pleasant tannins with a grainy texture. A wine of great personality.

SPBSR003 Nalan 2006, Cariñera

An attractive blend of the grape varieties Tempranillo, Cabernet and Merlot. The wine has a strong cherry colour with nuances of ruby. In the mouth, it becomes full, tasty and fruity, suitable for light dishes, pastas and mild cheeses.

SPLCR001 Juan de Alzate Gran Reserva 1995, Rioja

Complex stewed black fruits, good integration with oak and tinge of Tobacco, leather and black pepper. Well balanced, with a long finish, this wine is starting to open up after its long aging process.

This is followed by a broad, full-flavored wine with a supple texture and no hard edges. Drink this pleasure-packed wine over the next 2-3 years.

There are aromas of vanilla, creosote, black cherry, smoke and kirsch liqueur. The wine is full-bodied and opulent, with excellent structure and great definition. It will benefit from another 1-2 years of bottle age and drink for 6-8 years thereafter.

SWEET**SPTDW001 Ars Piameter 2007 (500ml)
(100% Moscatel), Malaga**

Attractive translucent straw-coloured wine. Very complex nose with floral notes, honey, quince, tropical fruit and minerals. Fresh in the palate, fruity, citric, very good balance sweetness vs. acidity, powerful with an after taste that confirms its complexity on the nose. Very long finish.

**SPVCW001 Castillo de Maetierra Melante (500ml)
(100% Moscatel), Valle de Sadacia**

Old gold colour. Intense nose of overripe fruit and honey, together with nuances of smokiness and vanilla from the cask. In the mouth it is very dense, with good acidity which perfectly balances the wine's high sugar content. Long, lingering aftertaste.

FRANCE

Ch Hosten-Picant

Chateau Hosten-Picant is a vineyard of 40ha, situated on the hills of les Lèves et Thoumeyragues. 32 hectares are devoted to reds and 10 hectares to whites. Short pruning are practiced to ensure a small harvest, and only use organic products on our vines and soils; no chemicals are involved. The vineyard's average age is 25 years. Harvest is done by hand. It is sorted and selected in the vines and then again in the wine shed. Chateau Hostens-Picant produces on average 200,000 bottles of wine per year under 4 labels. The Chateau had belonged to the same family for over 90 years before being purchased by Yves and Nadine Picant in 1986.

The wines are created with much ambition, the whites as much as the reds, and the Lucullus blend gradually became not only the best wine in its AOC but also one of the best built, most powerful Bordeaux wine to be found.

From 2004, this blend took a different path. Under the advice of wine consultant Stephane Derenoncourt, the tannins become lighter, the wine itself became longer and the wood became more integrated. The white wines progressed too.

WHITE

FRHPW001 Cuvée des Demoiselles 2005

Hint of citrus and grapefruits followed by white flowers, apricots and a slight touch of vanilla brought by the aging period in the oak barrels. In the mouth, this wine is round, wholesome and balanced, the Semillon grape brings the fullness, the sauvignon and muscadelle bring the freshness.

RED

FRHPR001 Chateau Hostens-Picants 2004 Classic Red

Hint of blackberries and peached. A fresh mouth that bursts with red fruits, a firm tannin content, blackcurrants come to mind immediately.

FRHPR002 Chateau Hostens-Picants 2003 Cuvée d'Exception "Lucullus"

This blend has gained in flavours and in finess. Structured and concentrated.

WHITE**Languedoc Roussillon****FRAWW001 Roche Mazet VdP Chardonnay 2006**

Straw-yellow colour with bright greenish tints. A fresh nose with a touch of pear, honey, fresh almonds and vanilla. This is a full-bodied, fleshy wine in the mouth with excellent aromas and a woody hint.

Chablis**FRCTW001 Domaine Bernard Defaix Chablis Vieille Vigne 2004**

The winemaking of this vintage highlights the full character of the terroir. 25% of this wine is fermented and aged in oak barrels with regular "batonnage" over 10 months. The remaining 75% is fermented and aged in stainless steel tanks on fine lees over the same time period. The final blend offers a rich, full-bodied wine whose delicate bouquet occasionally denotes hints of honeysuckle.

Bordeaux**FRAWW002 Chateau de Respides Blanc 2006, Graves**

A delicate wine with lots of citrus fruits and hazelnut. Elegant and well balanced on the palate.

Bordeaux Sweet**FRAWW003 Chateau La Cassade 2002, Ste Criox du Mont**

100% Semillon. Golden in color, nose of apricot and honey. Lovely sweet wine that grows in the neighbourhood of Sauternes.

FRAWW008 Chateau La Rame Reserve 2000, Ste Criox du Mont

Made from 100% Semillon. With a nose of intensified honey, fig and tropical fruits, this wine shows excellent balance and elegance, capping off with a long finish.

Alsace**FRPWW006 Pfaffenheim Pinot Gris 2005**

Rich, full bodied and with a long finish, It displays woodland aromas, sometimes slightly smoky , with characteristic opulence and roundness.

The wine is racy with definite finesse and hints of white peach. The taste is fresh and classy, ample and well-balanced with notes of lemon and mandarin. The finish is long and mineral.

FRAWW006 Pfaffenheim Goldert Grand Cru Gewurtztraminer 2002

Robust wine. Strong bouquet of musk, spice with mellowness in the mouth. Floral aroma such as rose petal can be detected. A slight bitter finish which provide a complexity in the taste.

FRAWW007 Pfaffenheim Black Tie ®Twistcap

Blend of Riesling and Pinot Gris. This wine has a wonderful delicate bouquet that combines light mineral notes with pleasant fruitiness.

RED**Languedoc Roussillon****FRAWR001 Roche Mazet VdP Cabernet Sauvignon 2005**

Mid Cherry Red. Attractive currants with hint of wood and plum. Medium bodied with layers of black fruits backed by oak flavours. Mid finished and well balanced.

Minervois**FRCTR002 Pouzol Premiere de Frontraliere 2002**

With an intriguing bouquet of cherries and spice; this well-structured, full-bodied blend of Carignan, Grenache and Syrah wine presents with light hearted flavors of spice, round red fruits and soft tannins

Cote du Rhone**FRCTR003 Domaine Mazurd and Fils 1999**

Supple scents of raspberries, herbs and fennel. Big and juicy fruit creates an impression of sweetness at first, opening into warm, tart and tannic flavors in a huge and structured wine.

FRCTR004 Domaine Mazurd and Fils 2000

Beautiful aromas that are reminiscent of blue fruits, then this sweet, spice rolls around your palate with a nice touch of tobacco & pepper.

FRCTR005 Domaine Mazurd and Fils 2003

Rich nose of red and dark fruits with smoky, meaty tones with a touch of licorice A huge structured wine.

FRCTR006 Domaine Mazurd and Fils 2004

Nose of plum, forest floor, cedar, clove, pepper. On the palate, am rounded with soft flavors of blackberry and a nice hint of that classic Rhone herbaceousness. Medium/soft tannins and balanced acidity with good finish.

Bordeaux**FRAWR008 Château de Bousquet 2005, Cote de Bourg**

Deep brick-red colour, elegant nos with fine wood and vanilla notes. Harmonious, fine and supple in the mouth, with friendly tannins. A well-made, medium-bodied wine. Long finish.

FRAWR009 Maro de Saint Amant 2005, St Emilion Grand Cru

Mineral notes and pleasant freshness; this wine has fruity aromas and firm tannins on the finish. 2nd wine of Chateau Villhardy

FRAWR010 Château Villhardy 2004, St Emilion Grand Cru

Dark red color, with good intensity. Red and black fruits aromas with strong cherry flavours and some slight spicy notes. The tannins are mature, offering a soft and lasting finish.

Cahors**FRAWR011 Clos Triguedina 2004**

100% Malbec. A delightful nose. Very perfumed, with sweet, crushed raspberry notes. This is showing lovely development. Full, sweet, voluptuous and textured on the palate. Plenty of supple, ripe tannins.

FRAWR012 Pfaffenheim Pinot Noir 2001

A beautiful bright strawberry cherry color. Fresh red berry and fruit aromas abound on the nose. An extremely fruity Pinot Noir with good balance, depth and structure and a great clean finish with soft tannins.
